

First Aid at Work Requalification Course

Description

It is a requirement of the Health and Safety law that employers should provide a safe and healthy environment for their employees. If the assessment of First Aid Needs highlights the need for qualified First Aiders, then this course will provide you with suitable, highly trained personnel. This comprehensive three day course covers a wide range of First Aid emergencies, enabling all participants to achieve a qualification in the highest level of First Aid, meeting the statutory requirements of the Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981.

Duration

A minimum of twelve hours spread over at least two days. Ideally, the course should be run over two consecutive days, but we have the flexibility to accommodate your specific needs if you so desire.

Syllabus

A range of subjects is covered including:

Legalities, responsibilities and reporting

Dealing with an unresponsive casualty

Resuscitation

Head injuries

Bandaging

Shock

Strains

Assessment of the situation

Control of bleeding

Eye injuries

Sprains

Choking

Poisoning

Burns and scalds

Fractures

Infection control

Certification

Subject to assessment, all participants will be issued with a certificate and a wallet card approved by the Health and Safety Executive for a further three years.

Numbers

A maximum of twelve people can be accommodated on this course and each participant must have a valid First Aid at Work qualification that has not lapsed by more than twenty eight days.
